

New Parking Conditions How To Guide

Visitors parking at Bicentennial Park, Blaxland Riverside Park and Parklands Junction P5b (URBN SURF) and P5c (Pump Track) will notice changes to the parking conditions taking effect on 1 February 2025.

These new changes will improve access to the parklands for more visitors to enjoy our beautiful green spaces. The new parking conditions will help to support the ongoing management of our parklands.

Register your vehicle plate number and receive the first 2 hours of parking free, then a parking fee will apply:

- \$3 per hour on weekdays
- \$5 per hour on weekends.

You can pay with Credit Card, Apple or Google Pay.

Ways You Can Pay

Touch Screen Meter

1. Enter your vehicle plate number
2. Select the time you will be parked
3. Pay



PayStay App

Available on Android or IOS

1. Download the app from the App Store or Google Play and follow the prompts to set up account
2. Enter the zone number shown on nearby signage or tap a Touch N Go virtual meter
3. Select the duration of time you'd like to park for, and press Start Parking



Touch N Go Virtual Meter – PayStay Guest

1. If NFC is enabled on your device, hold your smartphone close to the box and follow the prompts. Alternatively, scan the QR code. (Registered PayStay App users will be taken to the app).
2. Enter your number plate, state and mobile number and press 'Continue'
3. Select the duration of time you'd like to park for and press 'Continue'
4. Choose your payment method. You can choose Credit Card, Apple or Google Pay
5. Pay
